EXTENDING BOND FORFEITURE DEADLINES

WHEREAS, the outbreak of COVID-19 has caused a public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, The Governor of the State of Florida has declared a state of emergency; and


WHEREAS, The Florida Supreme Court and this Court have issued Administrative Orders setting forth emergency procedures during this period; and

WHEREAS, the court must fulfill its responsibility to protect the health and well-being of the public by adopting social distancing procedures in the Eighth Circuit to mitigate the spread of COVID-19,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. All deadlines pertaining to the forfeiture of bonds and/or the payment of bonds forfeited, are extended until July 1, 2020.
2. This Order shall take effect upon signing and shall continue in force until 5:00 pm on June 30, 2020.
